



NVQ2 Supply Chain Management (SCM)

Course Context

The NVQ2 in Supply Chain Management has been designed to meet the increasing demands within organisations to identify process efficiencies within the supply chain and to focus the business aims towards profitability.

Candidates are introduced to the main themes of supply chain organisation and co-ordination with significant emphasis being placed on customer and supplier relationships as individuals, as departments and as a business.

Who should complete the course?

The course is suitable for all levels of personnel across all departments and functions within an organisation, including shop floor, office and management staff.

Main Themes

- Process Flows and Waste
- Communication and Organisation
- Purchasing, Finance and Data
- Planning and Systems
- Performance and Governance
- Inventory and Storage
- Transport and Material Handling.

Course Style

The course is delivered using a variety of learning techniques and through the following methods:

- Presentations and work books for the dissemination and validation of information
- A hands on 'intervention' allowing candidates to apply knowledge in the classroom
- Practical activities including material process flow preparation and review
- An operational audit of the supply chain operation used to identify workplace issues

Course Content and Structure

The course is delivered over 3 - 5 days depending on individual client needs, using a mixture of classroom and work place environments.

Within the time the candidates undertake the underpinning knowledge and also have time to collect evidence and prepare their files for qualification.

The learning is based on between 12 - 15 candidates per course.

Outcomes

At the end of the course the candidate should be able to understand:

- The complexity and co-ordination required within the supply chain
- Have a wider appreciation of profitability within the organisation
- Have a wider comprehension of the work of other departments to secure business success
- Staff can identify where they fit into the supply chain and the impacts of their activities
- Identify where improvements within the Supply Chain may be made
